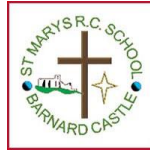

That others' families, either in school or in the wider world, sometimes look different from their family, but they should respect those differences and know that other children's families are also characterised by love and care.</p> <p>Caring friendships How important friendships are in making us feel happy and secure, and how people choose and make friends.</p> <p>Respectful relationships The importance of respecting others, even when they are very different from them, (for example, physically, in character, personality or backgrounds), or make different choices or have different preferences or beliefs.</p> <p>Being safe How to recognise and report feelings of being unsafe or feeling bad about any adult. How to ask for advice or help for themselves or others and to keep trying until heard. How to report concerns or abuse and, the vocabulary and confidence needed to do so, and where to get advice.</p>
